**Discussion:**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Conner.

Mayor Conner discussed:

- Announced receiving a decreased assessment from the PVA.
- Code enforcement office is now entering busy season and Carl Chapman will be missed.
- April 25<sup>th</sup>, two police officers will graduate from the academy.

Chief Cambron informed the council the newest fire truck is now 6 years old and the ladder truck is 15 years old. The ladder truck is in the shop and the estimate for repair will be \$10,000 to \$15,000 for repair. Purchasing a new truck takes 15 to 18 months for production. A new truck would cost the city approximately \$750,000. Butler Girls basketball team has been invited to the Pegasus Parade; we will be escorting them on a fire truck.

John Haywood announced May 5<sup>th</sup> the city is fully automated. Trash will now be picked up on Monday, Wednesday and Thursdays. Another issue is the dump is considering not allowing grass and leaves to be dumped if in plastic bags.

Mitzi Kasitz: all liens on delinquent property taxes have been placed. City hall now has all led lighting recommended by LG&E conservation go green recommendation.

Maria Johnson made a motion for a travel voucher for Ricky Guffey, second by Mr. Vance.
