**CITIZENS PARTICIPATION:**

Michael Gritton, Executive Director of KentuckianaWorks, it is the workforce development board/agency for Louisville and the six counties surrounding it. This year twelve to thirteen million dollars in federal money will be used to create career centers and run programs. Health and manufacturing is a focus of two separate career centers, a more familiar office that offers guidance is the unemployment office. Goodwill Industries runs The Power of Work for us, all with federal money, last year 400 people were able to get off welfare and into jobs. The City of Louisville and private funds are used for the Summer Works Program, for youth 16-21 years of age, we oversee that training program. Work experience in youth provides experiences they cannot learn in other ways. Those youth are more likely to work after having a summer job. The Medicaid waiver begins October 1, Kentucky is the first state in the country that will require able bodied participants, without dependents to do 20 hours of community engagement, work, community volunteer work or job training, per week. We hope Shively businesses will sign up to employ those we represent. Simply put, we help job seekers find jobs and good careers, education and training, and we help employers meet their workforce needs by connecting them with skilled, qualified employees.

Don Fowler, 2007 Foxhurst Drive, thank you to Mr. Burrell, he represents what Shively Block Watch should be, for helping a citizen suffering from dementia find his way home at midnight. This happened over one year ago but I wanted everyone to know.
