Ben Goldman, Director of Behavioral Health at Louisville Metro Public Health and Wellness, shared that their non-profit organization recently received Opioid Abatement Funding to expand services. They're partnering with Volunteers of America, Louisville Metro Department of Corrections, and CTS Russell, and hope to add Shively Police and other community organizations as partners. They provide group and one-on-one counseling for people without insurance, along with hepatitis C and HIV testing and connections to care. While they can't accept walk-ins directly, they help guide people to other providers. The organization plans to open an office at the Shively Professional Building, designed to feel welcoming rather than a government building. Because they operate a methadone clinic, strict regulations require a security officer during all hours of operation, a dedicated

entrance with keycard access, medication stored in a double-locked room with a safe, comprehensive video surveillance, and an emergency response plan in place.
