Mr. Vincent, I would like for Chief Frye to give a report on the shooting that happened at the club on 7th Street. Can you share any more updates, new reporters have called me and I have not answered them back.

Chief Frye, we served 5 search warrants on 5 different homes, outside of Shively, simultaneously, it could not have been done without the partnership we have with Louisville Metro Police Department, FBI, and ATF, we worked closely with them. Arrested on juvenile, 4 adults, over the weekend we feel like another person was arrested that will be possibly part of this, and there are more to come. Got 14 guns off the street, drug paraphernalia, and drugs. Our guys did an amazing and fantastic job, they worked 23 days straight, tirelessly to solve this.
